



## **NATIVE PLANT GUIDE**

### **for Vegetated Buffers & Other Development**

The following lists of plants are indigenous to the Renmark Paringa Council area and are usually available at all good garden centres and nurseries. It is strongly encouraged when planting a vegetation buffer or looking at plants for landscaping that consideration is given to local indigenous plants and planting at different heights to help protect and conserve native flora and fauna.

#### **Shrubs/Trees (5+ metres)**

<i>Callitris gracilis</i>	Southern Cypress Pine	5-15m
<i>Casuarina pauper</i>	Black Oak	6-10m
<i>Eucalyptus camaldulensis</i>	River Red Gum	10-20m
<i>Eucalyptus cyanophylla</i>	Blue-leaf Mallee	6-10m
<i>Eucalyptus dumosa</i>	White Mallee	3-6m
<i>Eucalyptus largiflorens</i>	River Box	6-20m
<i>Eucalyptus leptophylla</i>	Narrow-leaf Red Mallee	3-9m
<i>Eucalyptus gracilis</i>	Yorrell	3-9m
<i>Eucalyptus incrassata</i>	Ridge-fruited Mallee	3-7m
<i>Eucalyptus oleosa</i>	Red Mallee	3-12m
<i>Eucalyptus socialis</i>	Beaked Red Mallee	4-8m
<i>Melaleuca lanceolata</i>	Dryland Tea-tree	3-8m

#### **Medium to Large Shrubs (2-5 metres)**

<i>Acacia ligulata</i>	Umbrella Bush	2-4m
<i>Acacia oswaldii</i>	Umbrella Wattle	3-4m
<i>Acacia rigens</i>	Nealie	2-4m
<i>Acacia victoriae</i>	Elegant Wattle	3-4m
<i>Atriplex nummularia</i>	Old-man Saltbush	2-3m
<i>Callitris verrucosa</i>	Scrub Cypress Pine	3-5m
<i>Dodonea viscosa</i>	Sticky Hop-bush	2-4m
<i>Eremophila bignoniiflora</i>	Bignonia Emubush	3-4m
<i>Eremophila longifolia</i>	Weeping Emubush	3-5m
<i>Eremophila oppositifolia</i>	Opposite-leaved Emubush	2-3m
<i>Hakea leucoptera</i>	Silver Needlewood	2-3m



### Groundcovers, Climbers & Small Shrubs (Up to 2 metres)

<i>Carprobotus rossii</i>	Pig Face	2-3m (GC)
<i>Clematis microphylla</i>	Old Man's Beard	1-3m (C)
<i>Dianella revoluta</i>	Black-anther Flax-lily	1m
<i>Enchylaena tomentosa</i>	Ruby Saltbush	0.3-1m
<i>Eremophila divaricata</i>	Spreading Emubush	1-2m
<i>Eremophila glabra</i>	Tar Bush	1m
<i>Eremophila maculata</i>	Spotted Emubush	1-1.5m
<i>Goodenia varia</i>	Sticky Goodenia	2m (GC)
<i>Lomandra effusa</i>	Scented Mat-rush	0.5m
<i>Myoporum parvifolium (forms)</i>	Creeping Boobiolla	2-3m (GC)
<i>Oleria pimeiloides</i>	Pimelea Daisy-bush	1-2m
<i>Rhagodia spinescens</i>	Spiny Saltbush	1-2m
<i>Senna artemisiodes</i>	Desert Senna	1-2m
